#### ***Addressing Social Risk Factors in Quality Measurement***

- 1. There seems to be agreement that there are serious flaws in the current quality measurement system—therefore, what are the top 2 or 3 most important steps to take?***
- 2. If existing measures are not very meaningful for SNP populations, what would be more meaningful measures? How do we get from where we are to having these incorporated?***
- 3. There is unmeasured clinical /functional complexity and frailty in addition to the effect of these social risk factors—how can we capture these characteristics and stratify/group within the Dual population (as a start) to create distinct “clinically relevant” subgroups?***
- 4. How do we move from a few fixes “around the edges” to a longer-term solution/approach?***
